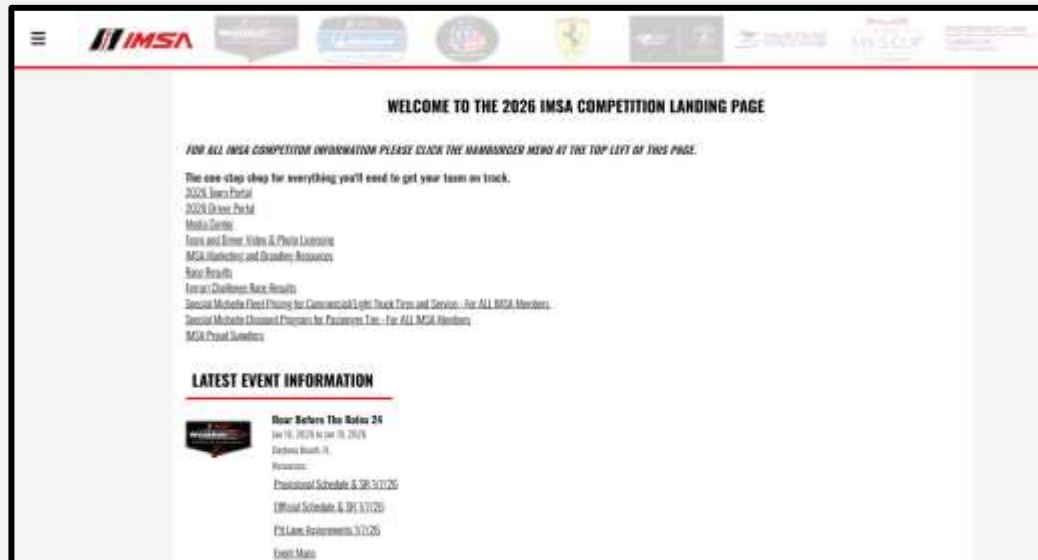

**PROHIBITED
ANY ONE, TWO OR
THREE-WHEEL FORM OF
TRANSPORTATION**

**ONLY PROPERLY
PERMITTED VEHICLES ACCEPTED
EXCEPTIONS FOR VESTED MEDIA
AND ADA TRANSPORT**

Motorcycles, drones, bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades and other non-motorized transportation, as well as motor scooters of one, two or three-wheels and/or designed to transport one or two persons, are prohibited in the garage, pit and/or Paddock areas except authorized power-driven mobility devices (ADA requirements - Americans with Disabilities Act), and accredited and vested media personnel.

Pit vehicles must only be operated by an IMSA credential holder. Motorized carts and similar 3- or 4-wheeled conveyances must not be driven into pit lane except pit equipment approved for a Series or as specified in the SR.

Such use in the Paddock must be for legitimate purposes only.

Excessive speed and/or unsafe operation is prohibited. Participants must abide by state laws and Promoter restrictions regarding licensing, maximum speed, helmet requirement and use.

Such conveyances may be prohibited at certain Events or in certain areas of each facility by local ordinance or Promoter limitation.

TO FALSE GRID, PIT LANE | GARAGES

Directions

1. From Garages, proceed to False Grid, located at South end of Trackside Garage building
2. Enter Racecourse via South Pit Gate
3. Enter Pit Lane
4. Proceed onto Racecourse



TO GARAGES (IWSC, IMPC, PCCNA)

Directions

1. Exit Racecourse onto Pit Access Road. Proceed onto Pit Lane
2. Take first right to exit Pit Lane. Proceed through Gasoline Alley
3. Proceed to assigned Garage

- Maintain a safe speed and distance when passing on-track incidents with Track Services team members present



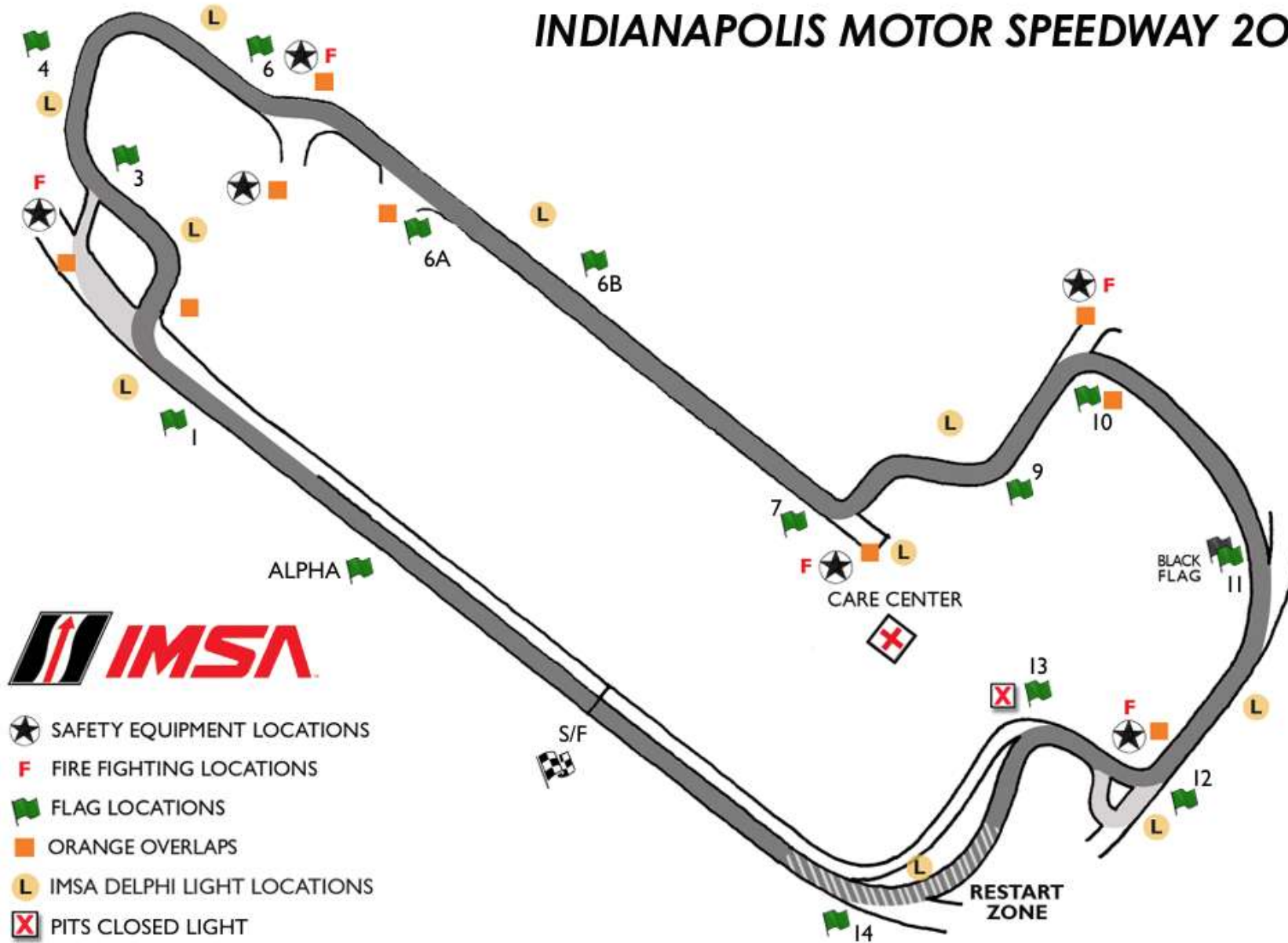

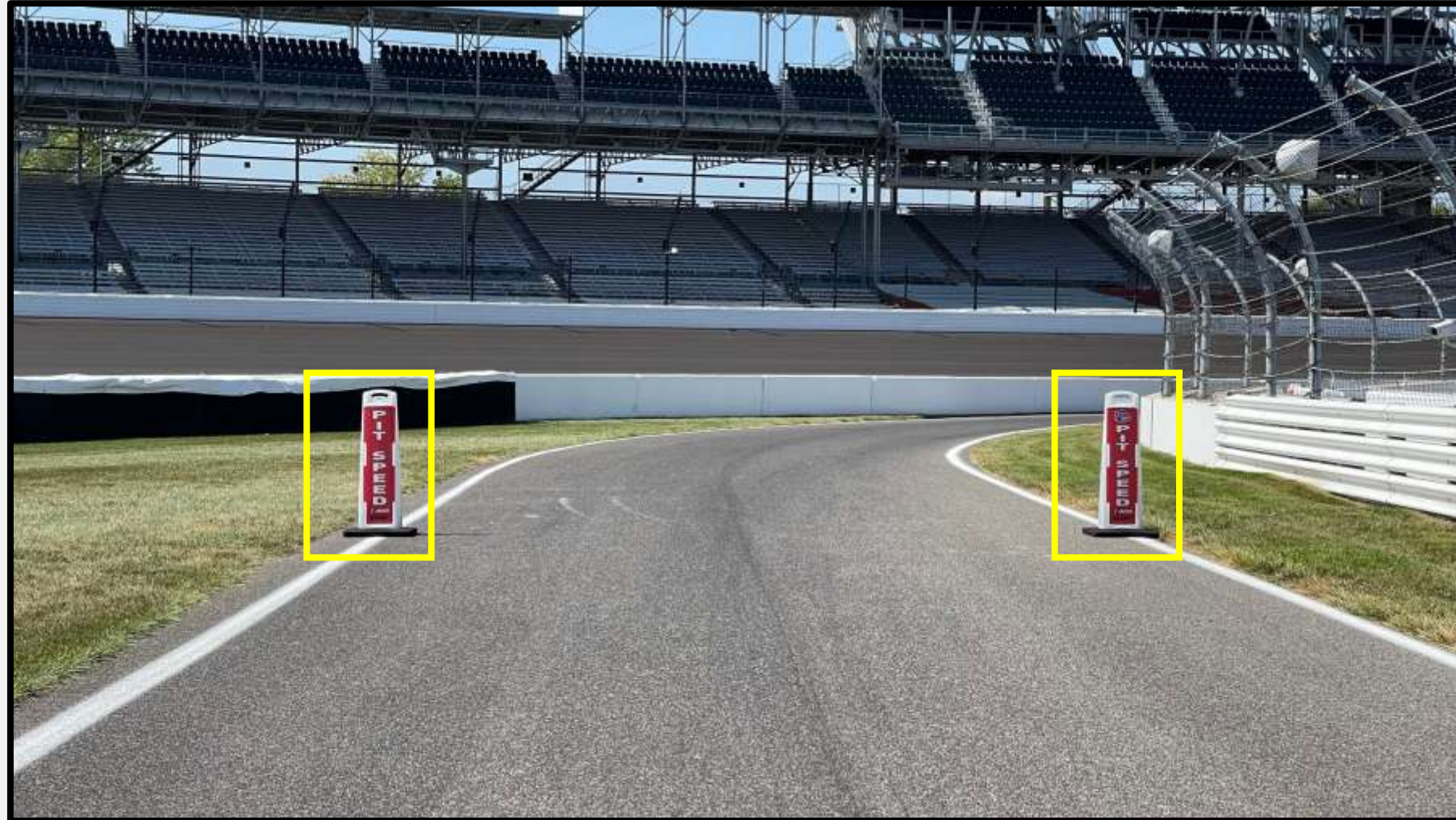


PIT ENTRY

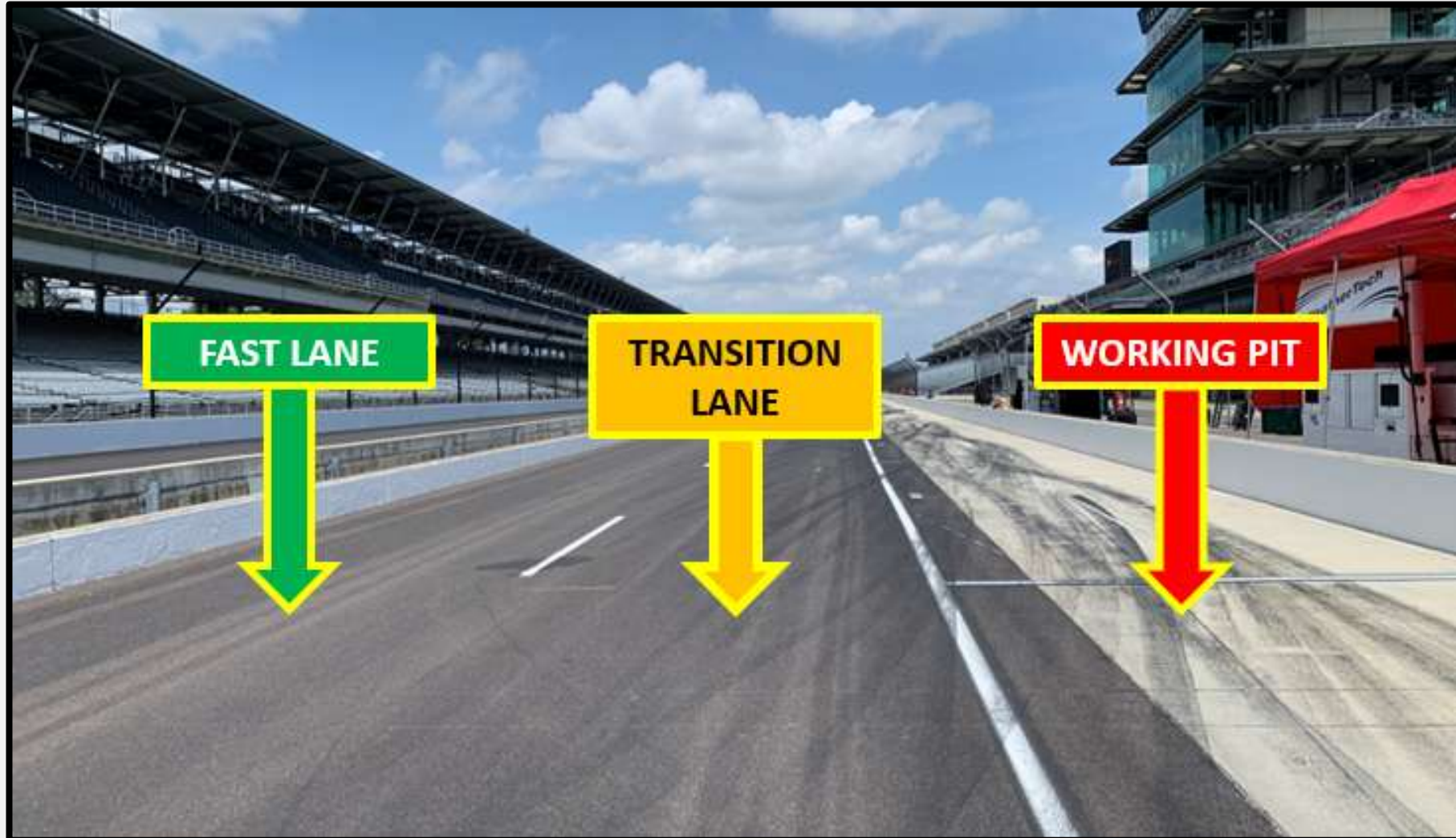


PIT LANE SPEED LIMIT STARTS

- Pit Lane speed limit begins at Red pylons.



PIT LANE PROTOCOL



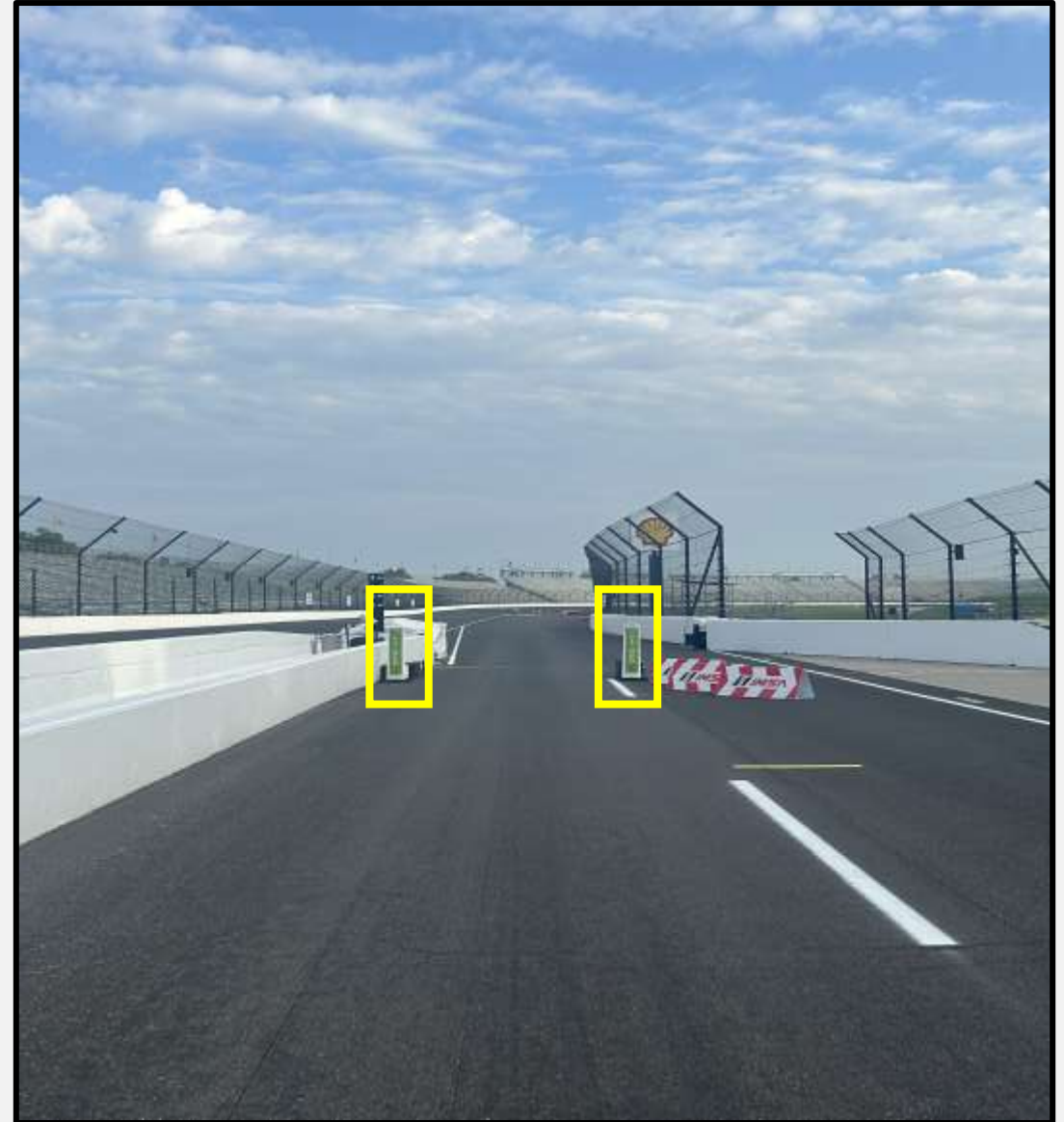
PENALTY BOX

- Penalty Box located driver's right at Pit Exit.



PIT EXIT

- Pit Lane speed limit ends at Green pylons.



PIT EXIT MERGE

- Cars exiting the Pit lane must remain two wheels to the right of the merge line past the apex of Turn 1
- Merge safely after T1



PIT EXIT MERGE

- Stay four wheels to the right of the Merge line until it ends
- Respect the speed difference of those on already on track



TURN 1 RUNOFF



TURN 1 RUNOFF & RE-ENTRY

CORRECT

TURN 6



TURN 7



TURN 12 RUNOFF

- Do not go straight and continue through speedway T1
- U-turn and make safe re-entry into T12
- Alternatively use the motorcycle chicane to make a safe re-entry



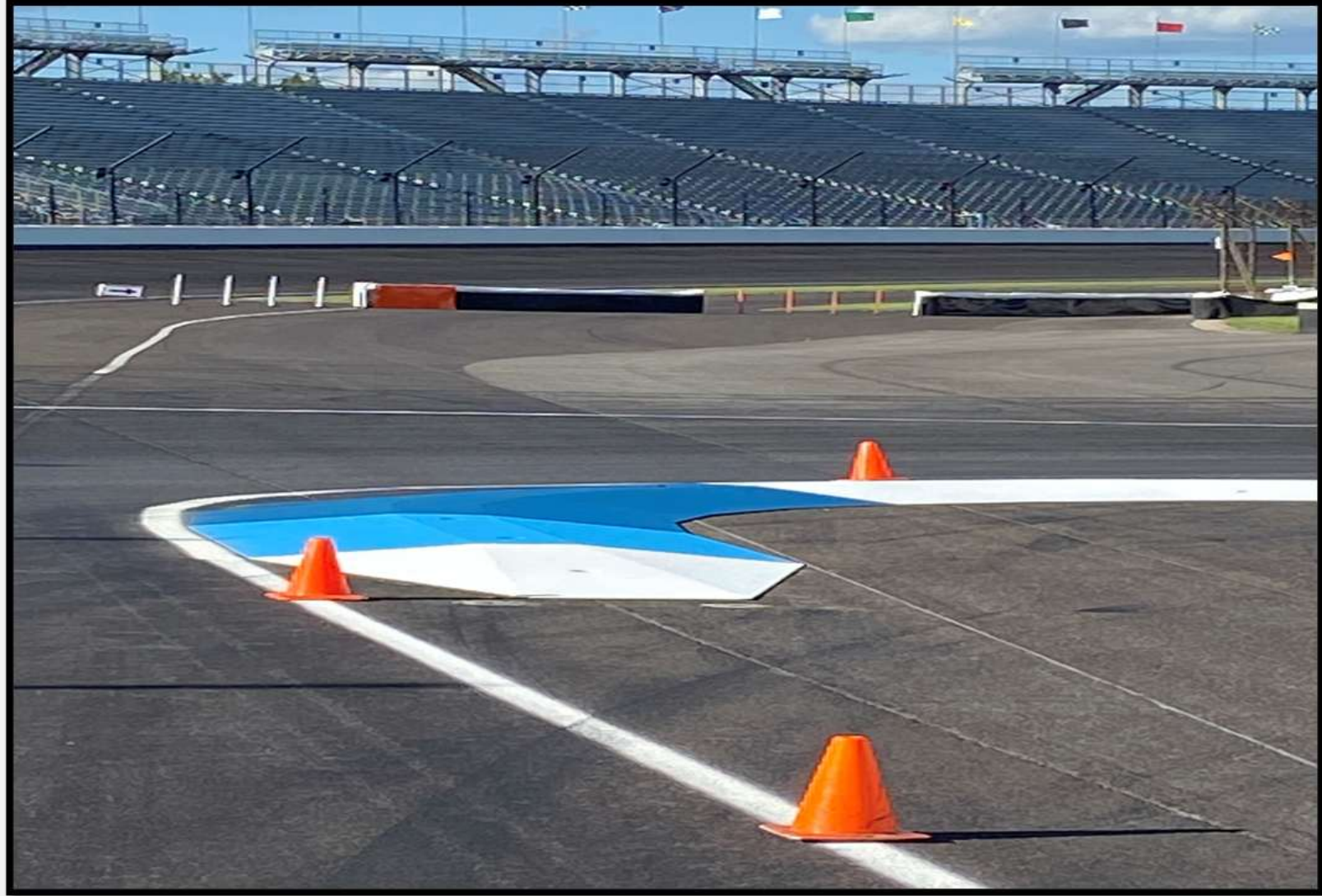

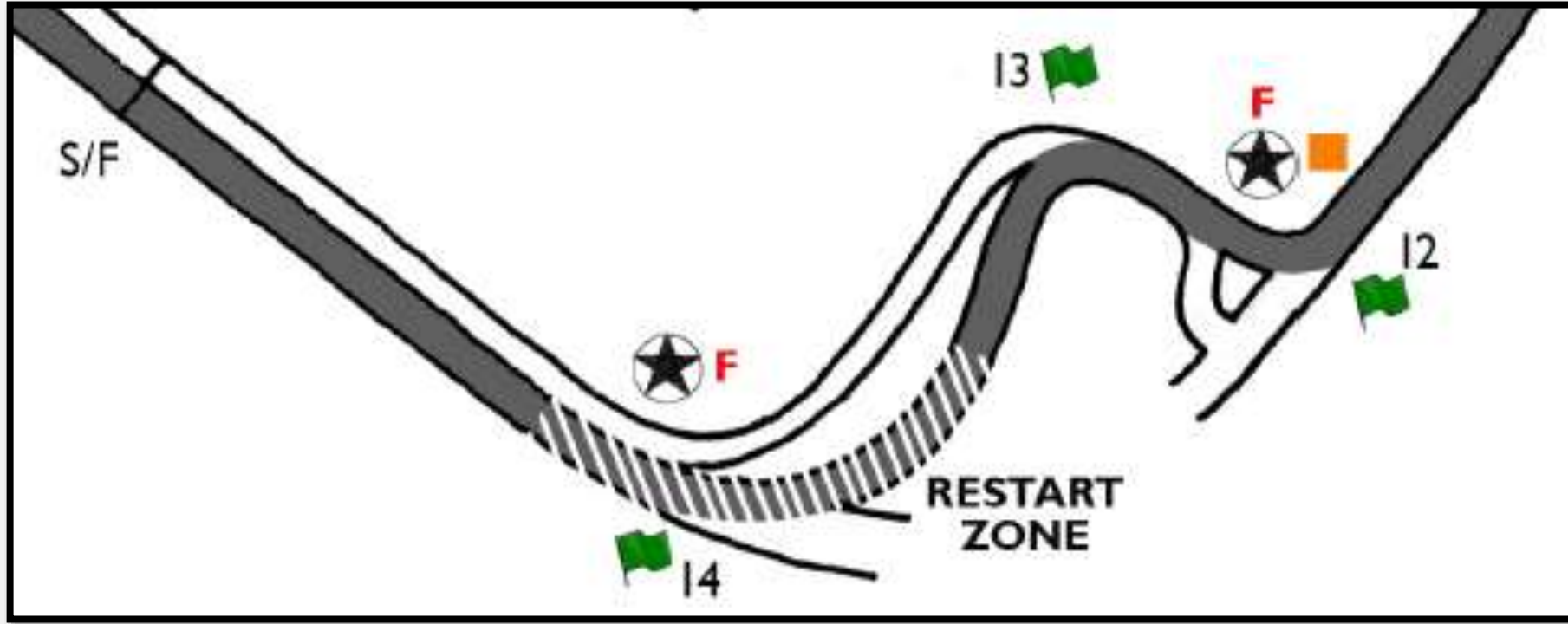

RACE START

- **Two (2) Formation Laps**
- **Split Start – GS and TCR (Two Safety Cars)**
- **Pack up first time by / Pair up out of Turn 11**
- **Stay with Safety Cars**
- **Safety Cars enter Pits**
- **Acceleration point**
 - Polesitters will be given instructions prior to the Race
- **P2 must maintain column until crossing the start line**
- **Official Race Start is second time by the finish line**
- **Jump/False start Reviews**
 - Gaps
 - Timed/Early Acceleration
 - Out of Line
 - Column Passing

FULL COURSE YELLOW (STANDARD)

- Pits closed
- Full Course Yellow (FCY lights and double yellow flags)
- Overall Leader – Safety Car speed
- Safety Car dispatched from T1 to Overall Leader
- Pass-Around
- Pits open - GS
- Pits open - TCR
- Final Wave-By
- Class Split
- Restart
- **Emergency Service Cars must D-T**
 - Emergency Service fuel Cars must fuel at first opportunity
 - Failure to perform emergency service drive-through: Stop plus 10 seconds
 - More than emergency service taken: Stop plus 60 seconds
- **Standard FCY not in effect during the last 30 minutes of a Race**

FULL COURSE YELLOW (SHORT)

- Pits closed
- Full Course Yellow (FCY lights and double yellow flags)
- Overall Leader – Safety Car speed
- Safety Car dispatched from T1 to Overall Leader
- Pass-Around
- Pits remain closed
- Class Split
- Pits open (all classes) after all Cars pass Pit-In, coming to the restart
- No Final Wave-By
- Restart
 - Speed*****
 - Gaps*****
- Emergency service Cars must D-T
 - Emergency service fuel Cars must fuel at first opportunity
 - Failure to perform emergency service drive-through: Stop plus 10 seconds
 - More than emergency service taken: Stop plus 60 seconds

MISCELLANEOUS REMINDERS

- **Pass-Arounds, Final Wave-Bys and Category/Class Splits are two-phase procedures.**
 - PREPARE
 - COMMENCE
 - Competitors who fail to prepare and/or commence when the commands are communicated from Race Control and subsequently lose positions will not be given positions back.
- **Multi-Class Racing**
 - Performance Differences
 - Downforce
 - Straight-Line Speed
 - Surprises
 - Interactions
 - Remain Predictable
- **Driver “Bandwidth”**

DRIVER COMBINE

- Takes place in the Administration building.
- At the Driver Combine, you will be able to complete all requirements for a 2027 Membership/Credential application including the application, annual physical, and ImPact test.

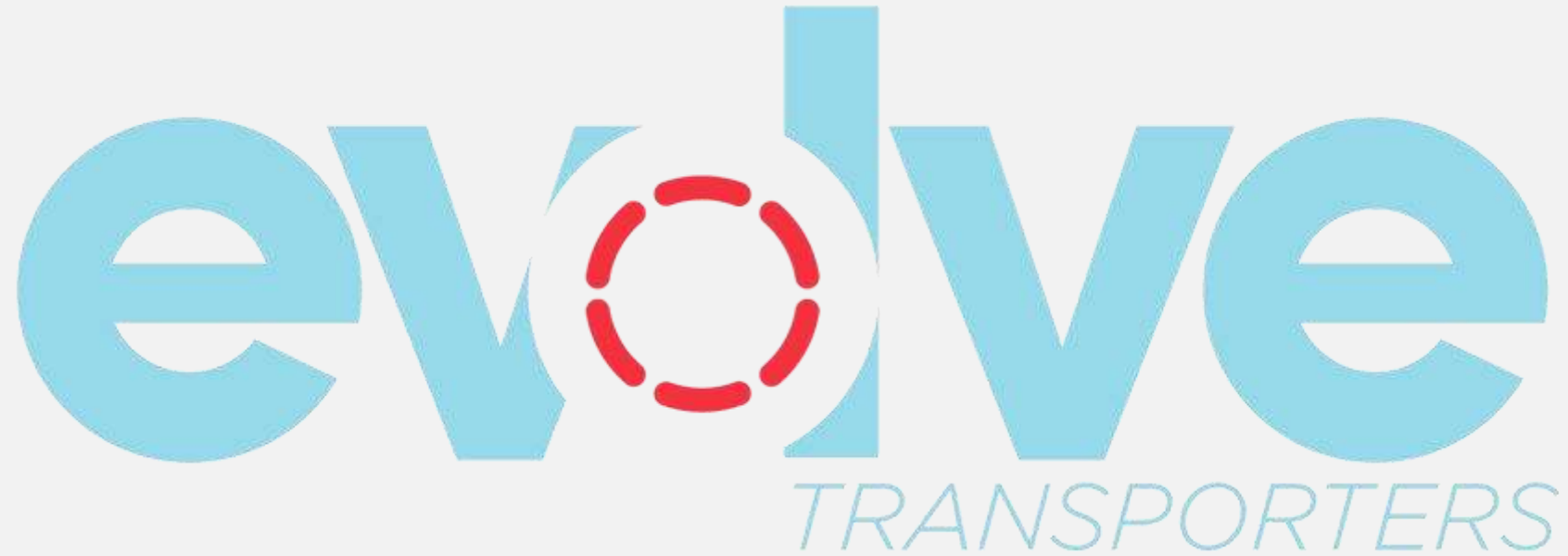
